Honoured Presidium of NAVIGA,

The Hungarian Association of Modellers hereby makes these proposals to change the rules of Naviga Section „M”

1. Decreasing the number of teams per country in classes Mini Eco Expert Team and Eco Expert Team.

Justification: The number of Teams in given classes is 5 teams per country now. These teams are organized not on base of ranking or the strength of drivers. Running these classes with high number of teams makes the organization of the competition difficult and it costs a lot of time (30-35 minutes with technical checks). We propose to lower the number of teams to 1 or 2 teams from each Country. This change would raise the prestige and the quality of these classes and could also make the competitions shorter.

2. Revision of merging F1-1kg and F1+1kg classes to F1E classes

Justification: The Hungarian Association of Modellers would like to ask Naviga to examine the question of merging the old F1 classes. This change made these classes less innovative, because the weight is not a point of view anymore. Hungary proposes to revision and restore the earlier categories. To avoid time problems in organizing, running only one category by each driver could be an option. (Participating in both classes wouldn't be allowed)
